happened last year. It is your responsibility to let your renters know the Community rules.

Fire pits, fire rings, fireplaces are not permitted outside either.



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BULLETS FROM THE BOARD - APRIL 2025

Wood Burning Fireplace Use – As a reminder from Tom's recent email on February 24, 2025, please
be aware of proper fireplace use. Although warm weather is finally approaching, there are still some
chilly evenings to enjoy your fireplace. Owners must ensure that, when building a fire, YOU MUST
OPEN THE FLUE FIRST. It also helps create an updraft if you open your sliding door an inch or two
for the first couple of minutes.

Since only owners are permitted to use any fireplace (wood or gas), the responsibility fully lies with the homeowner.

[If needed - stickers on fireplace rules are available from Tom at the MVA office.]
Failure to do this properly will result in the smokey situation as mentioned in Tom's email.
If this happens, we will enforce fines as outlined in the Mountain Villas Rules and Regulations.
NUISANCE (R&R Article 8.12) "noxious or offensive activity" which is subject to a Tier 1 volation fine. That's \$500 (plus \$50/hour for any additional office work related to the incident - minimum charge of \$50).

• Golf Course Reminders – The Highlands Golf Course is private property. It is not owned by either the Mountain Villas or by Seven Springs Resort. Unless you are paying and playing a round of golf, you technically shouldn't be on the course. The Golf Course Crew is on the course every morning at 6:00 AM and play can go on until 7:00 PM.

They have been very kind in letting people jog and walk their dogs during the off season, rainy days, etc. But that could be taken away if people trespass during golf season. Also, they insist you have your dog **ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES** when on the course. Lastly, carry a bag and <u>always</u> clean up after your dog.

• Please Pay Your Bills — As a friendly reminder, we rely on the homeowners to promptly pay their assessments and any outstanding bills. Your MVA is situated to ALWAYS pay our bills on time. We hope you appreciate our discipline. Remember, the homeowner is solely responsible for ensuring all assessments, bills, etc., are paid on time. This is not the responsibility of your bank, your financial advisor, or your friends and relatives. We appreciate those who remain conscientious of their MVA obligations.
